Central Police Officers are continuing to work hard on the issues within their community. Recently, six persons were arrested on suspicion of criminal damage in the Old Town area. We have also had one person charged with over 15 offences of criminal damage in the Rodbourne area. Broadgreen is continuing to work hard on its priorities, and is currently working with its partner agencies in relation to the issue of prostitution. A long-term strategy is being set up, whilst officers continue to be proactive, as demonstrated by the recent arrest of a kerb crawler. We are continuing to offer support to several educational establishments and the area of Broadgreen whilst Operation Dakota is going on.
