Locality based training:

Drop-in EYFS network meetings KEEP 6 (Experienced practitioners)

Description:

An opportunity for leaders and managers to meet informally to ask questions, raise issues/concerns and share effective practice with others. This will also provide an opportunity to share any SEN issues and concerns with your link EYC/Area SENCO.

Outcomes – you will have:

- Had the opportunity to raise questions with your link EYC and other leaders and managers in your locality
- Shared effective practice with other leaders and managers in your locality

Centralised training:

Leaders and Managers network meetings KEEP 5,6 (Experienced practitioners)

Description:

To keep up to date with recent EYFS research and share local and national initiatives with others

Outcomes – you will have:

- Had the opportunity to share effective practice with other Leaders and Managers
- Reflected upon provision and practice within your own setting and identified priorities for improvement and enhancement related to recent research

SENCO network meetings KEEP 2,5,6 (New, Established and Experienced practitioners)

Description:

To continually enhance practice in the early identification and assessment of SEN.

Outcomes – you will have:

- Reflected on how you as SENCO can further support all practitioners within your setting to ensure that conditions for learning and development are inclusive and meet the needs of children with SEN
- Considered effective multi-agency practice and materials available to further support early identification and assessment of children with SEN

Early Years Professional Status (EYPS) network meetings KEEP 5,6 (Experienced practitioners)

Description:

A chance to share good practice network and keep up to date with the very latest developments within the EYFS.

Outcomes – you will have:

- Shared and disseminated good practice.
- Ensured you are at the cutting edge of Early Years practice and developments.

Raising Expectations - Effective Monitoring for Leaders and Managers KEEP 6 (Experienced practitioners)

Description:

A one-day course designed to provide Managers, Supervisors, and Leaders with the knowledge and skills needed to raise the standards of education and care in their settings.
